

ITEM 5

- A. PCB material for disposal has two sources -- Monsanto production plant generated waste and customer returns. Disposal is either by incineration or landfill.
- B. For the years 1971 through October, 1975, at the WC Krumrich Plant, Sauget, Illinois, 15,237,000 pounds of PCB's have been burned. 510,000 pounds have been landfilled. Records are not complete and the numbers have some estimated values included.

For the same time interval 5,764,000 pounds of PCB's were landfilled at the Monsanto Anniston Plant. Records are not complete at Anniston.

- C. Total PCB's disposed of at the Sauget, Illinois site were 15,637,000 pounds.

Total PCB's disposed of at the Anniston site was 5,576,000 pounds.

- D. Attachments A & B are existing record summaries for internal and external sources of PCB's received at the Sauget, Illinois site.
